Ministry at New Life Church in Destin, FL

*The Apostle Paul was ordained by Christ to go to Rome to testify of Him. However, Jesus allowed him to go through two weeks of severe storms, shipwreck, and to be bitten by a viper. When Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks and laid them on the fire, **a viper came out because of the heat and fastened on his hand (Acts 28:3). But he shook off the viper into the fire and suffered no harm (Acts 28:5).** However, because of the incident with the viper, Paul was able to minister to all the sick people in Malta. Paul knew that his destiny was to go to Rome and not to die in Malta. Therefore, **he didn't even pay attention to the venom or effect of being bitten by a viper.** We too can face many different storms in life as well as being bitten by different kinds of vipers such as cancer, Covid, financial loss, accident, losing loved ones, etc. However, our final destiny is our spiritual Rome. So, **we also must not pay attention to the venom or effect of the viper and just need to shake it off into the fire of God** and move forward to fulfill His destiny in our lives—our journey to our Spiritual Promised Land...*
